

## Living Accommodations:

Much thought has been put into plans made for the comfort and pleasure of bridge players who will attend our tournament. The Minocqua housing committee stresses the fact that *advance, specific* reservations MUST be made, since the most select resorts, cabins and cottages for groups have been pledged to this committee, through which *all reservations* will be made.

The Minocqua Country Club is offering a special nine day rate of \$34.00 per person for room and board. Those who wish may use the club at a daily rate of \$4.00. It is here the tournament will be held, and it is here that the golf course is located. A special half-price green fee is available to bridge players. The Country Club can accommodate about 100 persons in rooms and cabins.

Woodlawn Resort, directly across the bay on Lake Minocqua from the Country Club, with a delightful beach, will be available at \$3.50 per person per day, for both room and board.

There are many comfortable, modern cottages, dotting the lake shore near by — cottages will accommodate parties of six to ten, and meals may be prepared there too. Cottage prices are from \$20.00 to \$30.00 per week, regardless of number of guests.

There are camps for tourists, and quiet rooms in private homes in the town of Minocqua (about a five minute drive from the club), for a dollar and two dollars per person.

Minocqua contains pleasant restaurants, and the Country Club can accommodate additional luncheon and dinner guests who have made advance reservations.
