10. Proposal to change 299er games to "non-life master 499er" games to better align WUMBA with ACBL – Mary Ann Romberg

Mary Ann also suggested that we no longer charge a different fee for these NLM games. Mike Selchert moved that we raise the entry fees to \$9 across the field as of October 1, 2017. Maria Roswall seconded. Pat Hoehne said that we could have a separate price for students (high school and college). Motion carried. Pat Hoehne, Mollie Freier, and Adam Gewiss will bring forward a proposal for youth/students. ACBL raised the minimum requirement for Life Masters to 500 points some years ago, and many tournaments have 499er tournaments instead of 299er tournaments. Maria Roswall moved that we move the 299er games to 499er NLM games effective January 1, 2018. Marge Morgan seconded. Motion carried.

#### 11. Eau Claire Regional – Rick Brown

Rick presented the flyer for Eau Claire. Rick said that the net profit for the regional was 20-24%. Rick has put 299er games on Friday and Saturday to encourage attendance on the weekend, which has historically been lower than the rest of the week. They are also have fewer KO games than in previous years. He also pointed out that the playing venue has changed this year, but he thinks it will help the bottom line. Rick asked that we encourage attendance.

12. Proposal Regarding Reimbursement for Teaching Bridge Classes – Mike Selchert Glenna Shannahan's e-mail. Jim Nikstad would like have a policy for the grants for ABTA, so that he does not want to have to make individual decisions about individual requests without a policy. We should have a maximum for the amount that we can budget for ABTA and for teacher accreditation programs. Maria Roswall, Carol Konrad, Marge Morgan, and Jim Nikstad will work on a policy and budget for these requests.
